THE PROJECT

Food Relations is a European project aiming at strengthening the spaces for social participation, intercultural communication and the integration of citizens from other countries in Europe, through the development and the sharing of experiences that value food as a tool for dialogue and inclusion.

THE CONCEPT

Food is a key tool for the process of intercultural dialogue and integration, as food is a human necessity and at a same time an occasion for exchanges and encounters of cultures and traditions.

In Europe there are an increasing number of integration practices that are the results of food-related activities, aiming at building virtuous and sustainable processes of dialogue and mutual understanding, creating relationships and opportunities for social and economic inclusion.

Urban and suburban community gardens, restaurants and catering services, new and various forms of social agriculture can be a place of gathering, understanding and for building new relationships, towards an active and global citizenship.

THE THREE STEPS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT

HAVERASTING

Collection and capitalization of European best practices for integration through food, by analysing the key factors and the best examples in terms of success and sustainability.

TASTING

Launching of various pilot activities by the project partners in Barcelona, Freiburg, Milan and Thessaloniki, following the recommendations collected during Step 1.

SHOWING

Promotion and dissemination of results and lessons learnt, through national and international events, aiming at promoting a sharing process among key actors and awareness about the project.
The debate at the European level and the making of a final documentary will allow to reach at least 100.000 Europeans and to contribute to a new narrative about migrations.





cofounder of Bonobo Films, is a filmmaker from Esparraguera. He holds a degree in Music Production from the School of Audio Engineering of Amsterdam and he is superior technician in audiovisual realization and shows. He has been responsible for audiovisual content for the NGO Agermanament, based in Barcelona. Among others, he was in charge of generating audiovisual content for the theater play "Històries d'Istanbul" (Festival Grec 2017 and Teatre Lliure 2018), or "MATRIA" produced by Temporada Alta and Fira Tàrrrega, both focused on documentary theater. He's been volunteering for years in Kurdistan, Cameroon and for some migrant youth projects in Europe.
